STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

This compact will enable the school and parents/families to share responsibility for student performance and success. The compact must explain how students, parents, families, and staff will share responsibility for student performance and success. This compact will give the details of the responsibilities that teachers, parents, and students have in helping the student accomplish their goals.
