Each person attending were welcomed and directed to sign in when entering through the cafeteria (3rd-5th grade). Families also came in at the Gym (Kinder – 2nd grade) where there was not a sign in. (Tried to catch as many as we could but only had one person for sign ins) Each person that signed in at cafeteria received the above information and were directed into the cafeteria where they received punch and a plate with a sugar star cookie with a tablespoon of icing. Sugar and decorating sprinkles were set out on the tables along with crayons and coloring sheets. Families were called by number to take a nice family photo with Nate Harvey, local photographer and a Christmas sELFie at the selfie station with Christmas props.
