

SHAC Meeting Minutes
October 26, 2017

- Discussion regarding our *Suicide/Crisis Plan* and next steps

Mrs. Pingel presented a draft plan. This plan was based from an exemplar model, and included feedback from PISD counselors. This plan is aligned with TEA requirements and our PISD safety/security plan. Our committee decided to turn this plan over to our counseling department. They will periodically work to suggest additions or corrections before bringing the plan back to the SHAC committee by May 2018. Once we feel confident with a final draft, we will present to stakeholders and post on our website.

- Discussion regarding *Big Decisions*, our Abstinence Plus curriculum (provide a template and next steps)

Mrs. Pingel presented a draft template for our abstinence plus curriculum. Our goal is to provide campus teachers and leaders a modernized template that explains the details, content, and goals for our lessons. We have asked counselors in grades 6-12 to form a committee and finalize a plan that is aligned with our *Big Decisions Curriculum* and incorporates the *Social Emotional Learning Curriculum*. Once this template is articulated, we will present and seek approval to the Superintendent and Board.

- Information on Rachel's Challenge

Mrs. Pingel presented information on this year's event, which will be held November 29, 2018 at the CAV building at PHS. We hope to extend last year's event by creating a "chain reaction." This will be a full-day event with our PHS student leaders. We ask volunteers, community members, and several faculty members to join us for this important day.

- Information on new EpiPen protocol

Dr. Sieck will provide two stocked EpiPen's per campus. Ms. Gutierrez feels that parents will be happy with the doctor providing a written prescription. If we used the Pen, he would follow up with the patient. This set-up allows for immediate assistance, if needed, and should provide an additional safeguard in case of an emergency.

- Other department updates/discussion items for our next meeting

The committee wanted to know our progress with the CPR updates. Nurses are currently inquiring about being instructors. Several teachers in the special education setting have been provided the proper certification. Mrs. Gutierrez will report back at the next meeting.
